

Legal Description

a certain tract of land located in the First Civil District of Cheatham County, Tennessee, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the E. line of State Highway No. 49, G. B. VanHook's N. W. corner; thence, S. 87° E. 49 poles to a stone, about $1\frac{1}{2}$ poles W. of a branch, Poole's corner; thence N. 5° E. $31\frac{3}{5}$ poles to J. F. Tucker's corner, near an old culvert; thence, with Tucker's line, N. $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. $39\frac{4}{5}$ poles to a point in the E. line of State Highway No. 49; thence following the line of said Highway the following distances and bearings: S. 42° W. 28 poles; S. 35° W. 8 poles; thence, S. 28 poles to the beginning, containing 12 acres, more or less, according to survey made by Jesse E. Hudgens, on April 19, 1943.

And being a part of the same tract of land conveyed to S. H. Adkisson, and wife B. Adkisson, by deed from W. T. Clark, and wife, recorded in Deed Book "O", page 316, Register's office of Cheatham County, Tennessee.
