AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into this first day of July, 2025, between the Tennessee Department of Health, hereinafter referred to as the STATE, and CHEATHAM County, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY.

WHEREAS, it is the vision of the Tennessee Department of Health to be in the top ten states in the nation for health, and

WHEREAS, it is the mission of the Tennessee Department of Health to protect, promote, and improve the health and prosperity of the people in Tennessee through the prevention of conditions that may be a threat to health, individually and collectively, and through the treatment of conditions that have already affected the health of Tennesseans, and

WHEREAS, TCA 68-2-901, provides a means for a State and County effort to accomplish these mutual goals through the delivery of health services through the local health departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the parties have agreed and do hereby enter into this agreement according to the provisions set out herein:

A. THE COUNTY AGREES:

1. To appropriate a total of \$69,063 for support of the CHEATHAM County Health Department. This amount consists of:
 - a. \$36,643 Direct-Local funds (for which the COUNTY shall not be billed); in accordance with Item 3 below.
 - b. \$32,420 of appropriation for which the COUNTY shall be billed in accordance with Item 3 below.

2. To use revenues generated from the provision of health services toward the support of the County Health Department
3. To pay the STATE biannually one half of the total county funds appropriated for the purposes of this contract as identified in Item 1 (b) above. Payments are to be received by the STATE no later than the last day of January for the first payment, and no later than the last day of April for the second payment (Jan. 31, and Apr. 30 respectively).
4. To report all local expenditures to the STATE quarterly.
5. To submit to the STATE a duly signed and executed county agreement.

B. THE STATE AGREES:

1. To provide a total of \$755,100 in support of the CHEATHAM County Health Department.
2. Upon written request, to provide a reporting of all expenditures and revenues.

C. BOTH PARTIES AGREE:

1. It is further agreed that the funds shall be used to pay salary, longevity, fringe benefits, travel, meals and/or lodging and other necessary expenses. The salary and travel, meals and/or lodging payments shall be paid in accordance with State regulations, policies and procedures, and subject to funding availability.
2. The term of this agreement will begin July 1, 2025, and shall extend through June 30, 2026.
3. This agreement may be amended in accordance with procedures established by the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Health. All amendments must be reduced to writing.






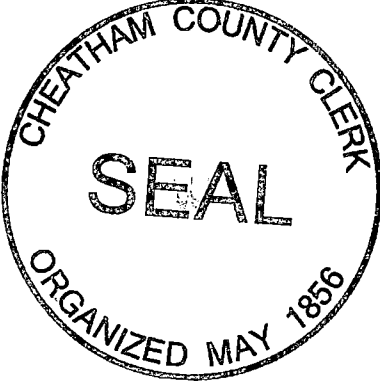

SECURE DETENTION CONTRACT
BETWEEN
BEDFORD COUNTY JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER
AND CHEATHAM COUNTY

This contract for secure detention care services for juveniles is by and between Bedford County Juvenile Detention Center ("BCJDC") and Cheatham County, TN ("County"), hereinafter referred to as BCJDC and County.

In consideration of the mutual promises and amounts set out below, the parties enter this contract according to the following provisions:

1. That upon available secure bed units within the BCJDC, the facility shall provide detention care services for those juveniles ordered to be detained by the court having jurisdiction of juvenile cases within the county within the provisions of the contract. This order shall be based on the detention criteria set forth in TCA 37-1-114.

Detention care services shall consist of detaining the juvenile in the BCJDC and providing said juvenile with three (3) meals a day, shelter and such other physical necessities as may be determined by the director of the BCJDC. BCJDC reserves the right to refuse placement of a child under the age of twelve (12) without prior approval of the detention director.

2. That actual placement at the facility will be preceded by a telephone call by County personnel expressing intent and approximate time of arrival and departure (931-680-9720). That upon the Judge or Referee of the Court with juvenile jurisdiction not being available or accessible, either of the following persons shall be allowed to place juveniles with a signed petition and a detention order signed by the Juvenile Court Judge and delivered at the time of placement and/or emailed to BCJDC. The designated persons authorized to place juveniles and obligate said county under this contract are:

It shall be noted that BCJDC has the obligation to refuse placement if the call is not made by one of the aforementioned persons. Thus, the aforementioned persons are the only persons allowed to make arrangements for the placement of juveniles.

3. That BCJDC reserves the right to refuse placement under this contract under the following circumstances:
 - a. That, as determined by BCJDC personnel, secure bedroom space is not available.
 - b. That, as determined by BCJDC, said juvenile is an imminent threat of harm to him/herself or other residents because of his/her emotional state.

4. The County agrees that it will be responsible for the cost of any emergency, medical, or dental care if determined necessary for the BCJDC personnel. In the event prolonged medical or dental attention is required, BCJDC personnel will notify County of such conditions and County shall assume responsibility for and make arrangements for such care. The County agrees to authorize the Judge or Referee of the Court with the juvenile jurisdiction or the designated officers as listed herein to sign appropriate forms: which would authorize medical attention and local medical facilities for said juveniles in case emergency care is deemed necessary by the BCKDC personnel and the appropriate medical personnel.
5. That the County shall, per Minimum Standards for Juvenile Detention Facilities, adhere to the requirements that a physical examination shall be completed on a youth within fourteen (14) days of their initial confinement date which examination shall follow the protocol as specified in Subsection (4). In the event that any youth is from a county other than Bedford County; then said youth must likewise have said physical examination as provided under the Guidelines and the county from which said youth comes shall either arrange for and provide for the physical examination as required or, failing that, shall agree to pay for said physical examination as conducted by Bedford County for Bedford County youth at a minimum costs of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per examination.
6. That the County shall, at its own expense, transport all juveniles to and from the BCJDC.
7. That BCJDC personnel are authorized to release duly placed juvenile of said County upon written order from the Judge or Referee of Court having juvenile jurisdiction or officers of the Court of said County or to party as enforcement officers of said County or to party as designated by the written order.
8. That regular charges are One hundred and forty-five dollars (\$145.00) per day. Any part of the initial day is counted as a full day.
9. The terms of this agreement are in effect until either party terminates the agreement.



**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE
MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT
CHEATHAM COUNTY, TN

This **FIRST AMENDMENT** ("First Amendment") is effective as of April 6, 2026 ("First Amendment Effective Date") and amends and supplements the Master Services Agreement by and between Securus Technologies, LLC ("we," "us," or "Provider") and Cheatham County, TN ("you" or "Customer") dated April 1, 2025 (the "Agreement"). All capitalized terms contained but not defined herein are defined in the Agreement.

WHEREAS In 2024, the Federal Communications Commission published the *Incarcerated People's Communication Services; Implementation of the Martha Wright-Reed Act: Rates for Interstate Inmate Calling Services*, WC Docket Nos. 23-62 & 12-375, FCC 24-75 (rel. July 22, 2024) (the "2024 FCC Order") which, among other things, lowered the rates for voice and video calls and prevented providers from paying cash or in-kind commissions out of revenue regulated by the FCC.

WHEREAS On June 30, 2025, the FCC published an order (the "Waiver Order") extending the compliance dates of the following requirements of the 2024 FCC Order to April 1, 2027: new caps on voice and video calls, the prohibition against cash or in-kind commissions, and the requirement that providers offer video calls on a per-minute basis.

WHEREAS On December 5, 2025, the FCC published an order in the Federal Register (the "Interim Order") which, among other things, adjusted the 2024 FCC Order rate caps to include the costs of investigative products and safety and security services as adjusted for inflation, and allowed a per-minute additive to the call rate to account for costs customers incur in allowing access to IPCS.

NOW, THEREFORE, as of the First Amendment Effective Date and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Term.** This First Amendment shall commence on the First Amendment Effective Date and shall remain in effect through the Term of the Agreement.
2. **Voice Calls Cost.** Provider will charge \$0.13 per minute voice call-rate to the incarcerated end user, plus applicable taxes, tariffs, fees, and surcharges, in compliance with state and federal regulatory requirements. International rates, if applicable, will vary by country.
3. **Video Calls Cost.** Provider will charge \$0.21 per minute video call-rate to the incarcerated end user, plus applicable taxes, tariffs, fees, and surcharges, in compliance with state and federal regulatory requirements. International rates, if applicable, will vary by country.
4. **Cost Recovery.** Provider will pay Customer \$0.02 per minute of both the voice call rate and the video call rate indicated above as recovery of costs incurred by Customer for allowing access to audio and video services respectively.
5. **Compliance with FCC Regulations.** The First Amendment includes terms to comply with the current Interim Order. There is the potential for its requirements to change during the Term of the Agreement. If any such changes occur during the Term of Agreement, the parties agree to work together in good faith to agree to appropriate changes to address such changes. Additionally, current FCC regulations do not allow Provider to charge ancillary service charges on transactions involving voice and video calls. If the FCC allows Provider to charge ancillary service charges on transactions involving voice and video calls in the future, Customer agrees that Provider may charge such fees, up to the maximum amount allowed by the FCC, without the need for further contract amendment or customer approval.
6. Except as expressly amended by this First Amendment, all of the terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.



BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, That the Cheatham County Legislative Body meeting in Rescheduled Session this the 2nd day of February 2026 in the General Sessions Courtroom at the Courthouse in Ashland City, Tennessee, WHEREAS, The Health and Educational Facilities Board of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee (the "Nashville Board") has been requested, pursuant to Part 3 of Chapter 101 of Title 48 of Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended (the "Act"), to issue one or series of tax-exempt revenue bonds (the "Tax-Exempt Bonds") and one or more series of taxable revenue bonds (the "Taxable Bonds" and, together with the Tax-Exempt Bonds, the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,500,000,000, the proceeds of which will be loaned to Vanderbilt University Medical Center or an affiliate thereof ("VUMC") and used for various purposes, including but not limited to, approximately \$2,000,000 for the financing, refinancing or reimbursing the acquisition, construction and equipping of property and improvements located at 166 Centre Street, Pleasant View, Tennessee 37146 (the "Cheatham County Project"); and

WHEREAS, Section 48-101-308(a)(5) of the Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended, provides that the Nashville Board may not undertake the financing of a project located outside of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee (the "County") except after the approval of such financing by appropriate resolution duly adopted by an entity designated in said Section 48-101-308(a)(5); and

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Cheatham County, Tennessee (the "Governing Body") is the appropriate governing body, as designated by the Act, to adopt such resolution, with respect to facilities in Cheatham County, Tennessee and the Cheatham County Project referred to above is located in Cheatham County, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, VUMC has requested the Governing Body to approve the issuance of the Bonds to comply with Section 48-101-308(a)(5) of the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:


