These elections are not in the new budget and the county will be responsible for the costs. Pam advised she has spoken with May McCarver and Sandrine Batts in accounting regarding these unplanned expenses. She will update the commissioners once dates for these elections have been set. Pam recommended cancelling the July meeting in preparation for upcoming meetings that will be required as a result of the special called elections. This will help offset budgeted commission pay. All commissioners were in agreement and there will be no July meeting.
